MOSQUITO FALLS (0n30 Gauge)



Our Canadian logging layout has a fictional link with our society. There being a company De Havillands (Canada) which built aircraft such as the wooden Mosquito bomber during the Second World War and that still exists today (unlike the founding De Havillands company in England). Thereafter a new company De Havillands Timber was founded to supply the aircraft factory with the highest quality timber. The end result, is an 'L' shaped layout consisting of four separate dioramas. By breaking the layout into four, it has been possible to design it in a modular form, giving flexibility in layout plan and allowing future expansion by individual members of the society.
